

Here are other great ways to help grow YOUR reader: "Things That Go"

Baby (0-12 months): Point out different vehicles while taking walks or reading with your baby. Use simple names: truck, car, fire truck, bicycle, airplane.

Toddler (1-3 years): Build "roads" along floors and name the different vehicles you play with; talk about vehicles they might not see every day, like wagons or tractors, using books and pictures.

Preschooler (3-5 years): Have your child name different vehicles. Talk about what they do and if they are related to a particular profession or activity. Sing a song about your favorite things that go.
