NEW YORK TIMES - ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS



STEP 1

Visit Albany Public Library's Research Databases page, and click on the link for New York Times Newspapers. You may be asked to enter your library card number.

STEP 2

Click on "Go to Publication Search" near the bottom right.

STEP 3

In the Publication Search box, type in "The New York Times." One of the results will be The New York Times; The New York Times Company. Click on that.

STEP 4

You can now choose a particular issue by selecting a date from the Full Text Coverage calendar. It will show you the articles from that day's issue.

Another option is to type a keyword into the SEARCH WITHIN PUBLICATION box on the right. After doing an initial search, you can change or add to the search by clicking on the blue "Revise Search" text at the top of your results list. This will allow you to continue searching just within the New York Times.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Photos are not available through these databases.
- Anyone can access the full-text of New York Times articles from 1/1/1981-12/31/1986 through https://www.nytimes.com/search/ Pre-1981 articles, as well as articles after 1986, appear to require a subscription.
- If you are looking for a recent article, try searching for keywords from the article rather than the title of the article. The titles in these databases often don't match the titles found in online versions of The New York Times.
- New York Times Magazine articles are not available in these databases. However, they are available through GALE Academic OneFile on our Research Databases page.
- New York Times Book Review articles are not available through any of our databases.
